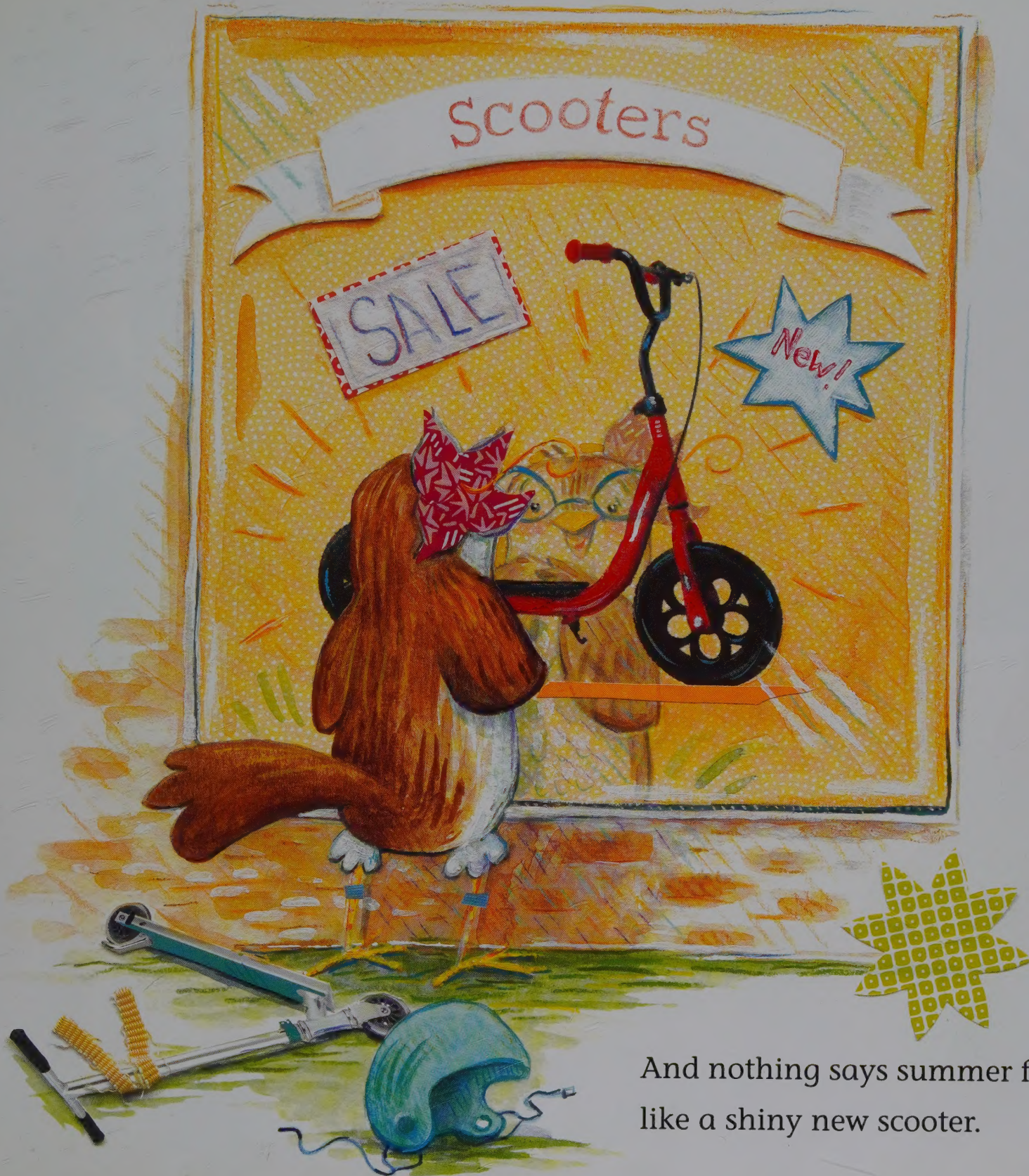

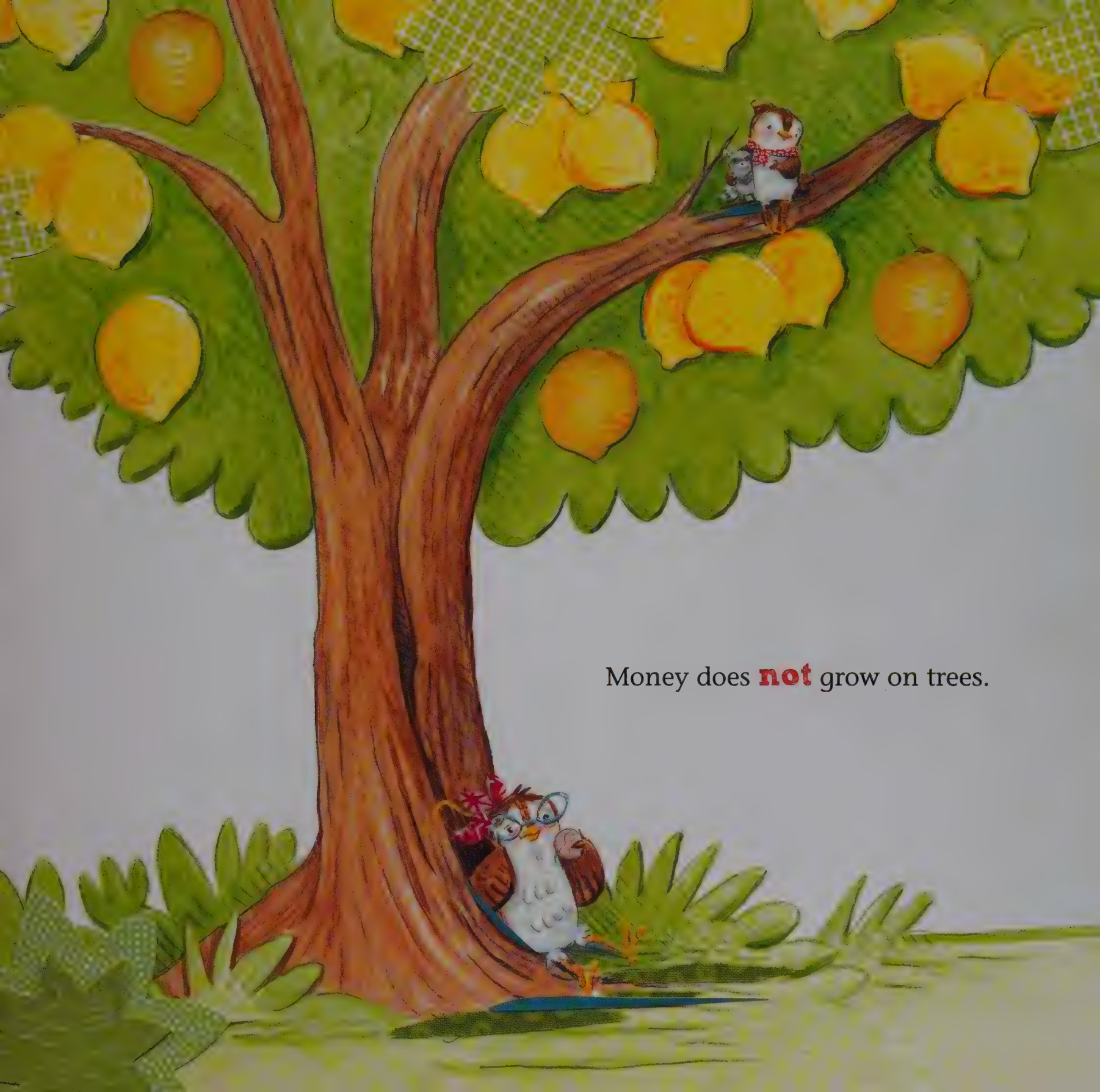




And nothing says summer fun

It will need to **look** good.



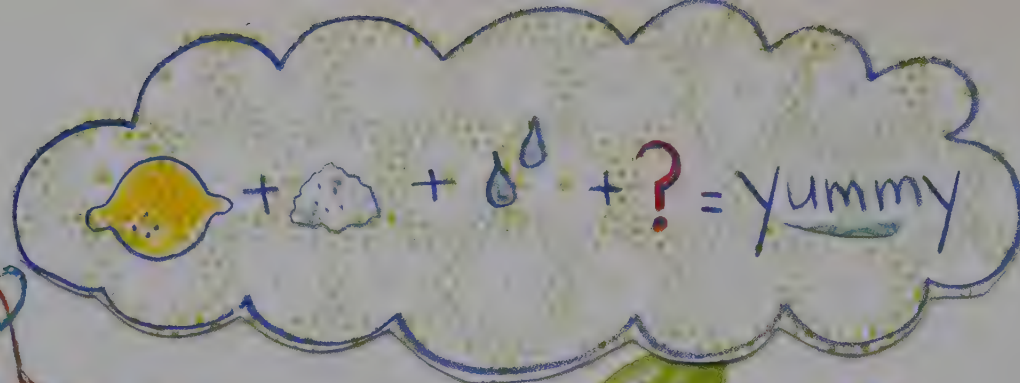

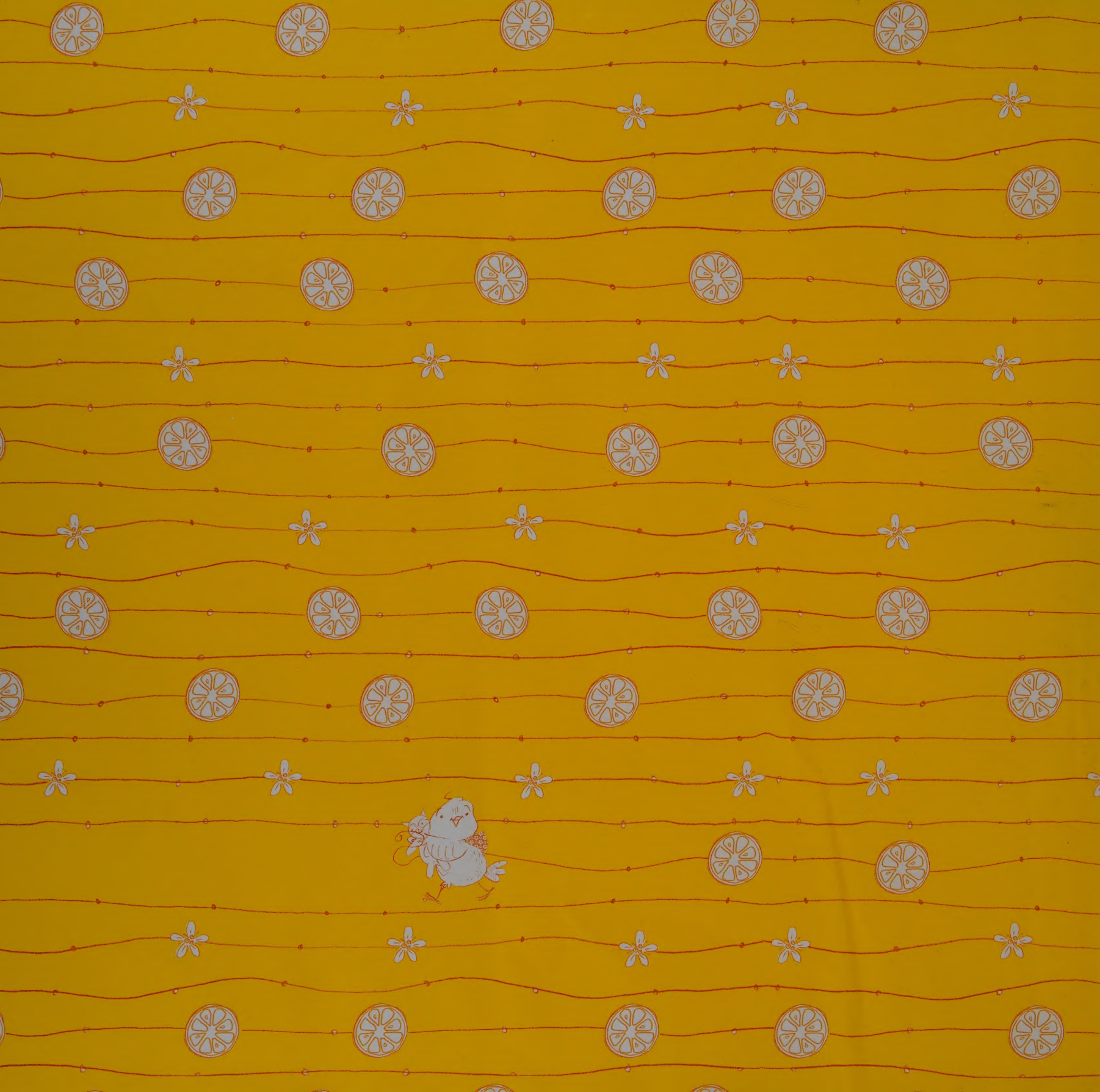
