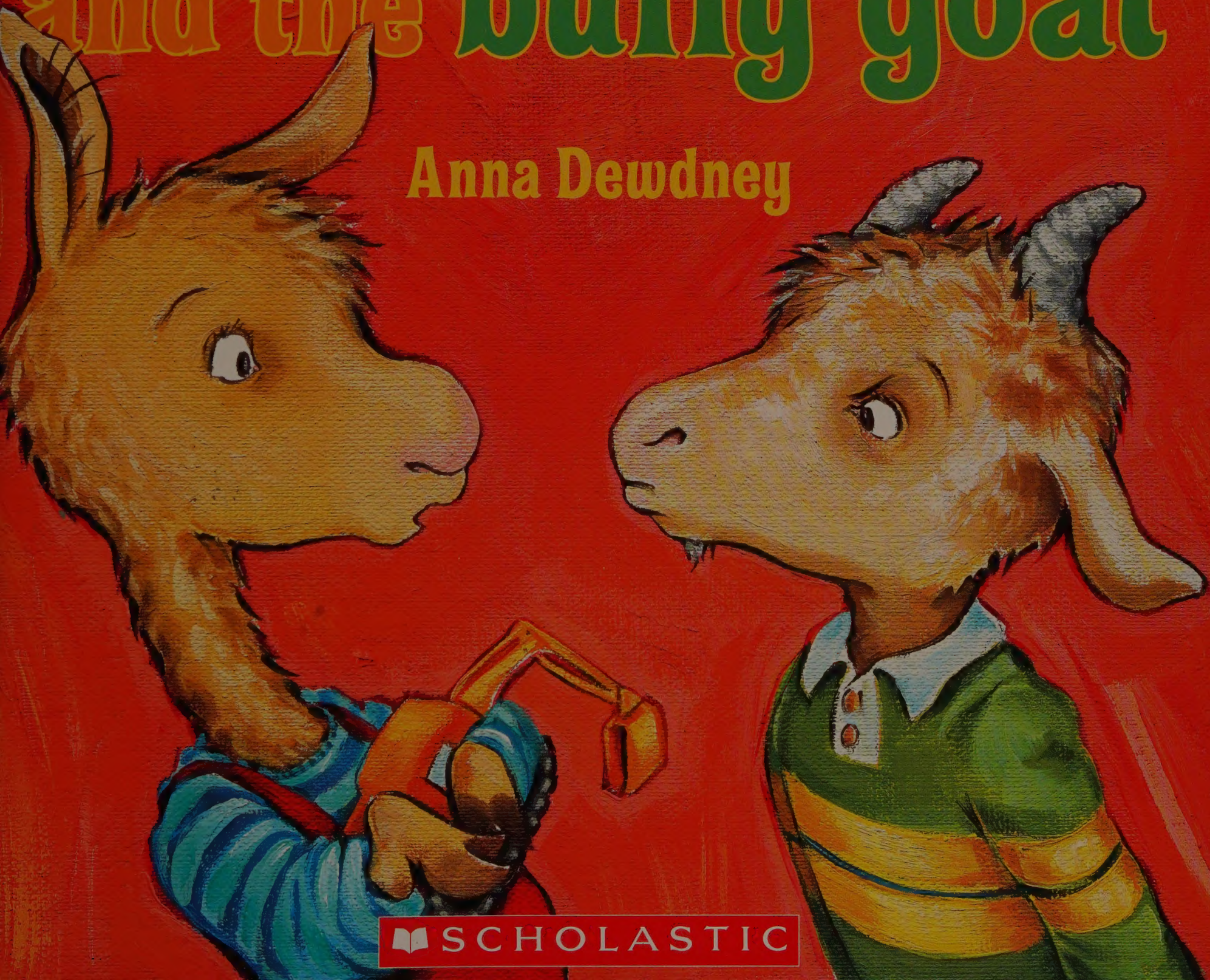

Writing, counting, pictures, clay.





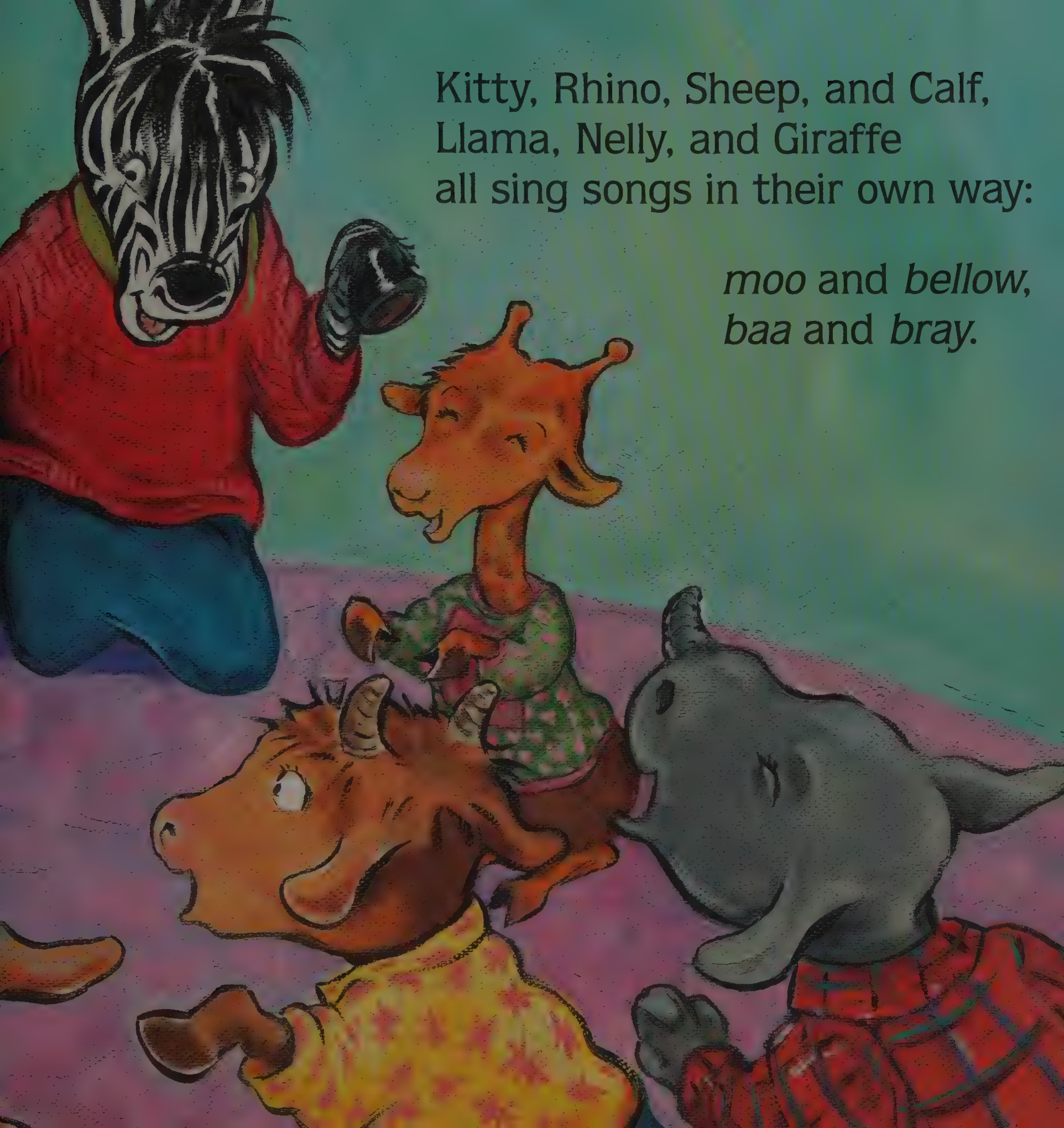
Roll a pancake. Draw the sun.

Gilroy thinks that's silly, too.



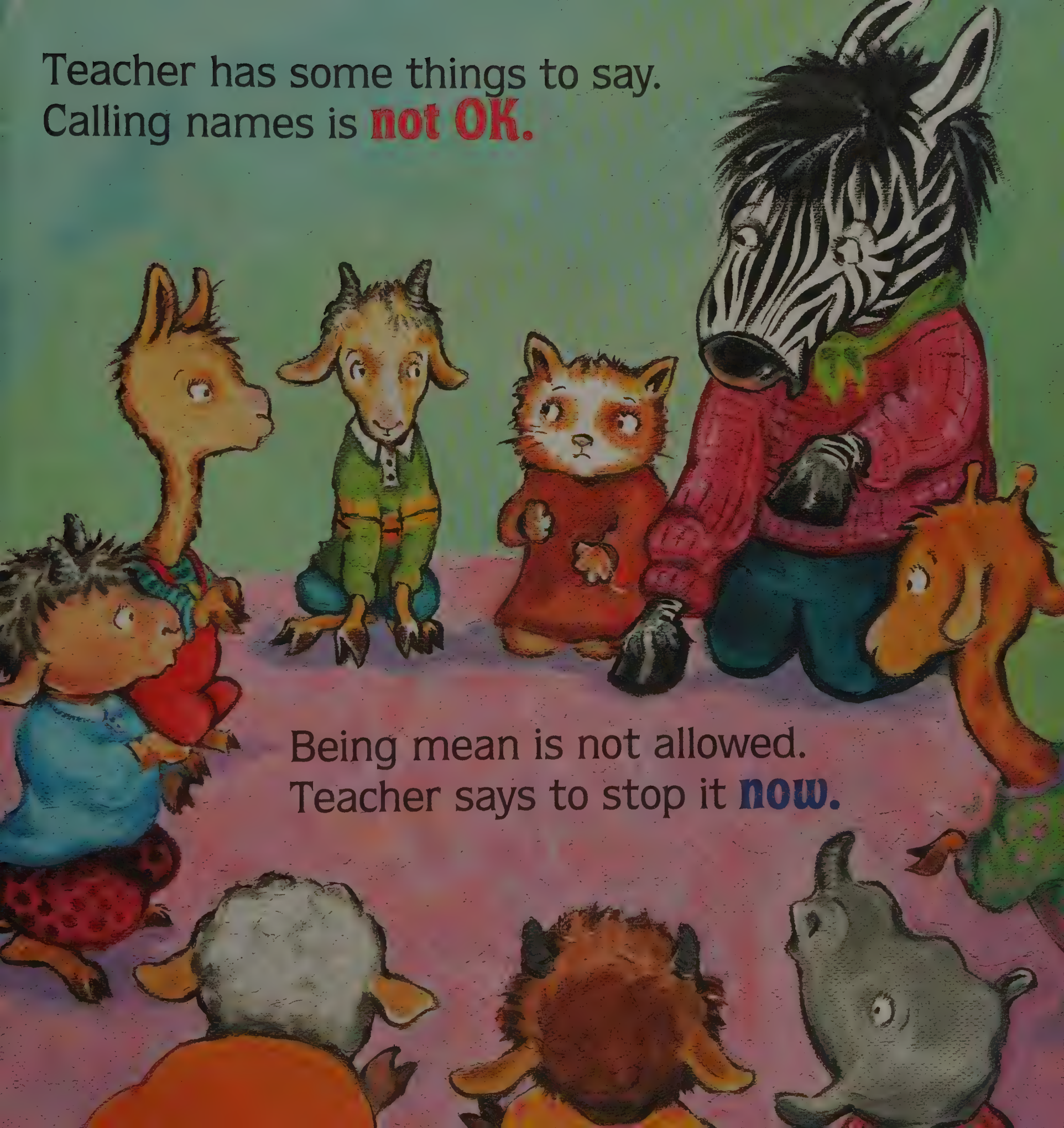
Llama Llama likes to sing.

GOAT!



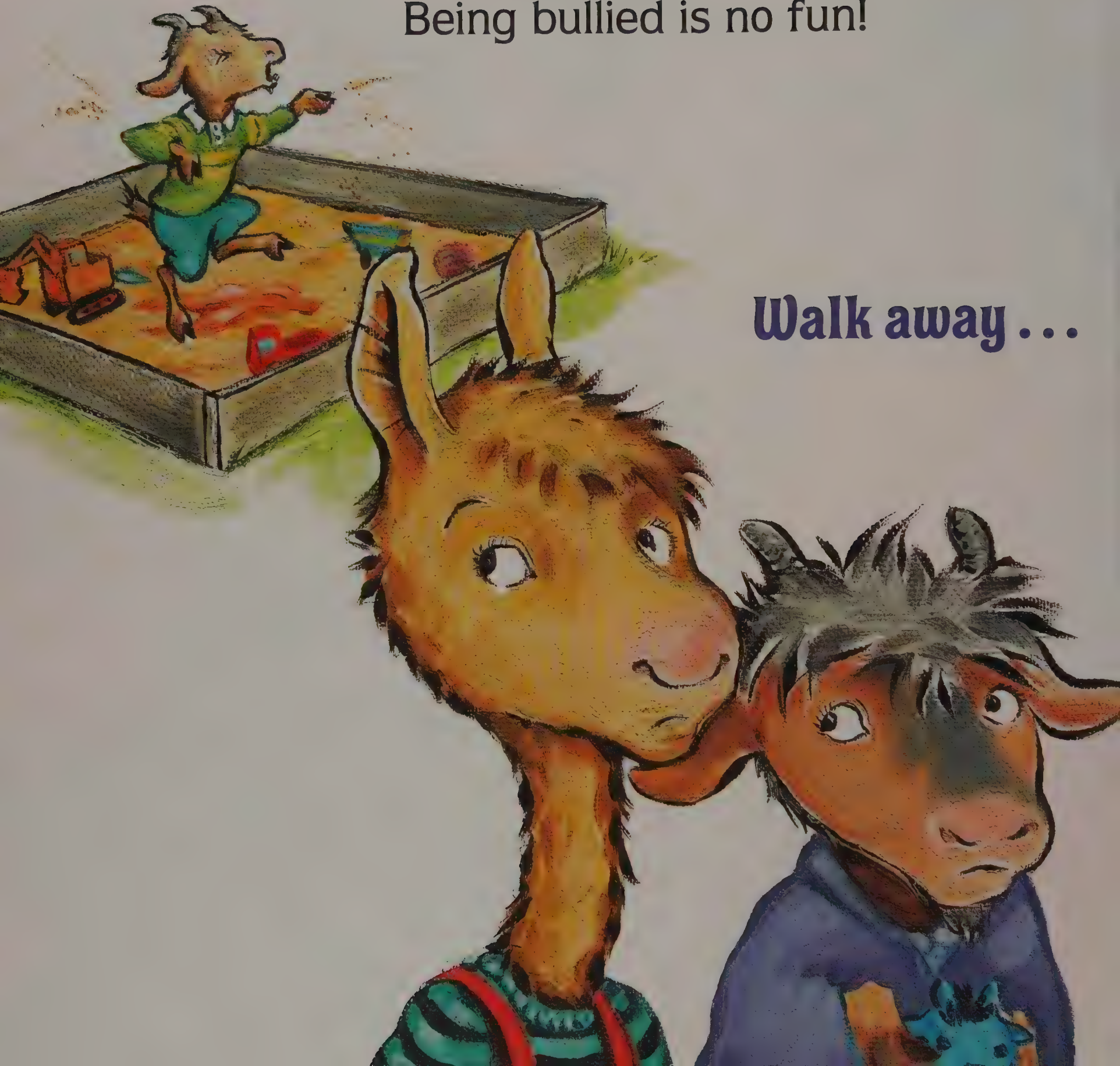


Gilroy, this is **not OK**.

Gilroy, can you be a **friend**?



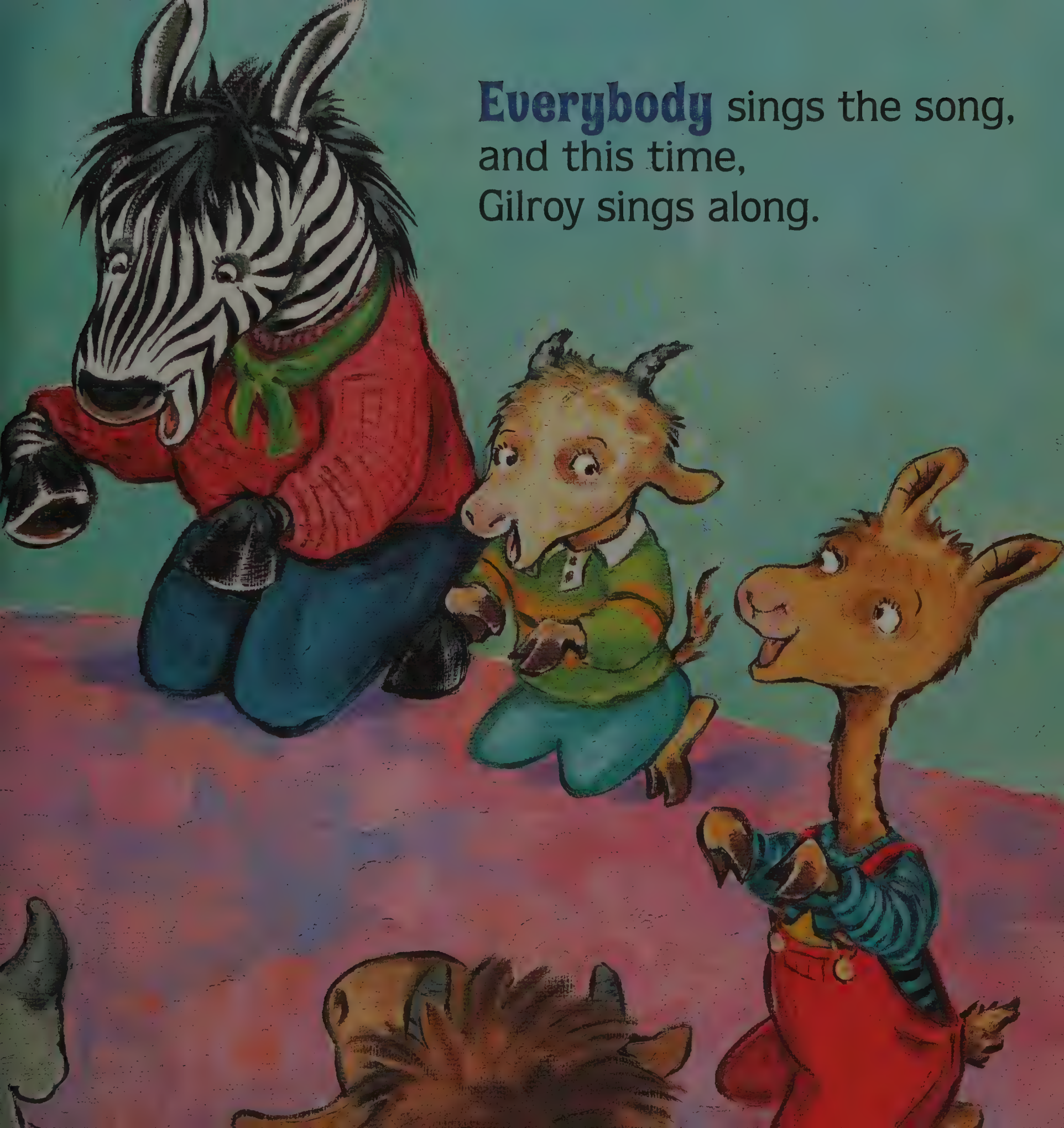
No more kicking. No more names.
