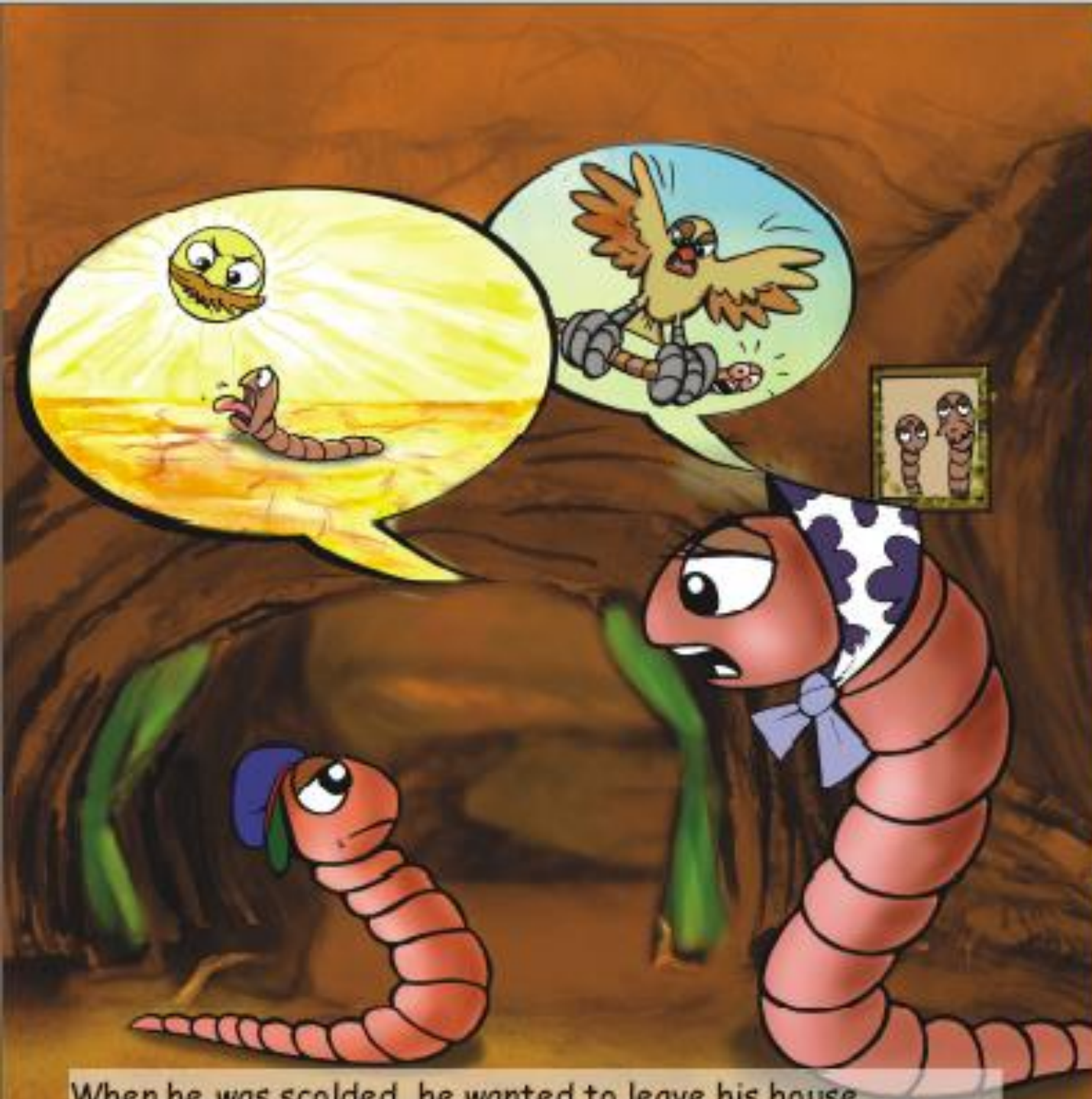


Munna The Disobedient Earthworm

HE RAN AWAY.





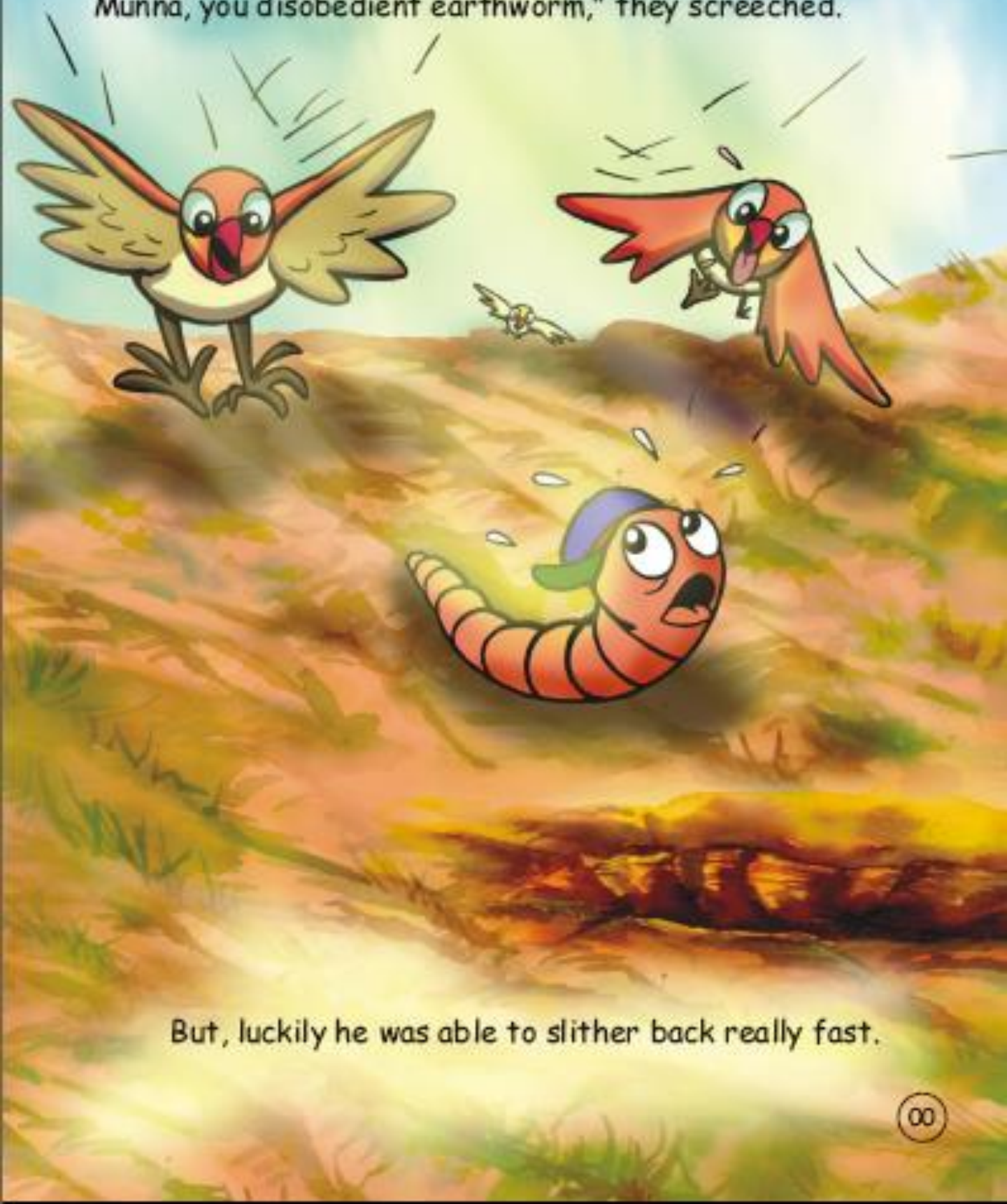
He dug himself out of the ground and went on the top.
